### Airborne Pollutants

The Peabody Orlando is a custom-built Orlando hotel. It opened its doors in 1986 and catering to the meetings and conventions industry nationwide. The front entryway is surrounded by beautiful coral fountains that have been subject to mold and mildew from the humid weather in Orlando, as well as pollutants of cars and buses.

The Peabody is located across from the Convention Center, therefore susceptible to environmental pollutants. After many years of harsh chemicals to clean the coral, the stone was slowly deteriorating. The hotel was looking for a solution to keep the coral clean and protected.

GFI crew removed the pollutants from the coral using a safe detergent. Once it was dried Glass Fusion™ NS100 Natural Stones Sealer was applied. This provided a durable barrier for the stone to withstand airborne pollutants. It provides 100% UV protection and reduces the mold growth. The fountain is easy to maintain without using expensive chemicals and high pressure washing.
